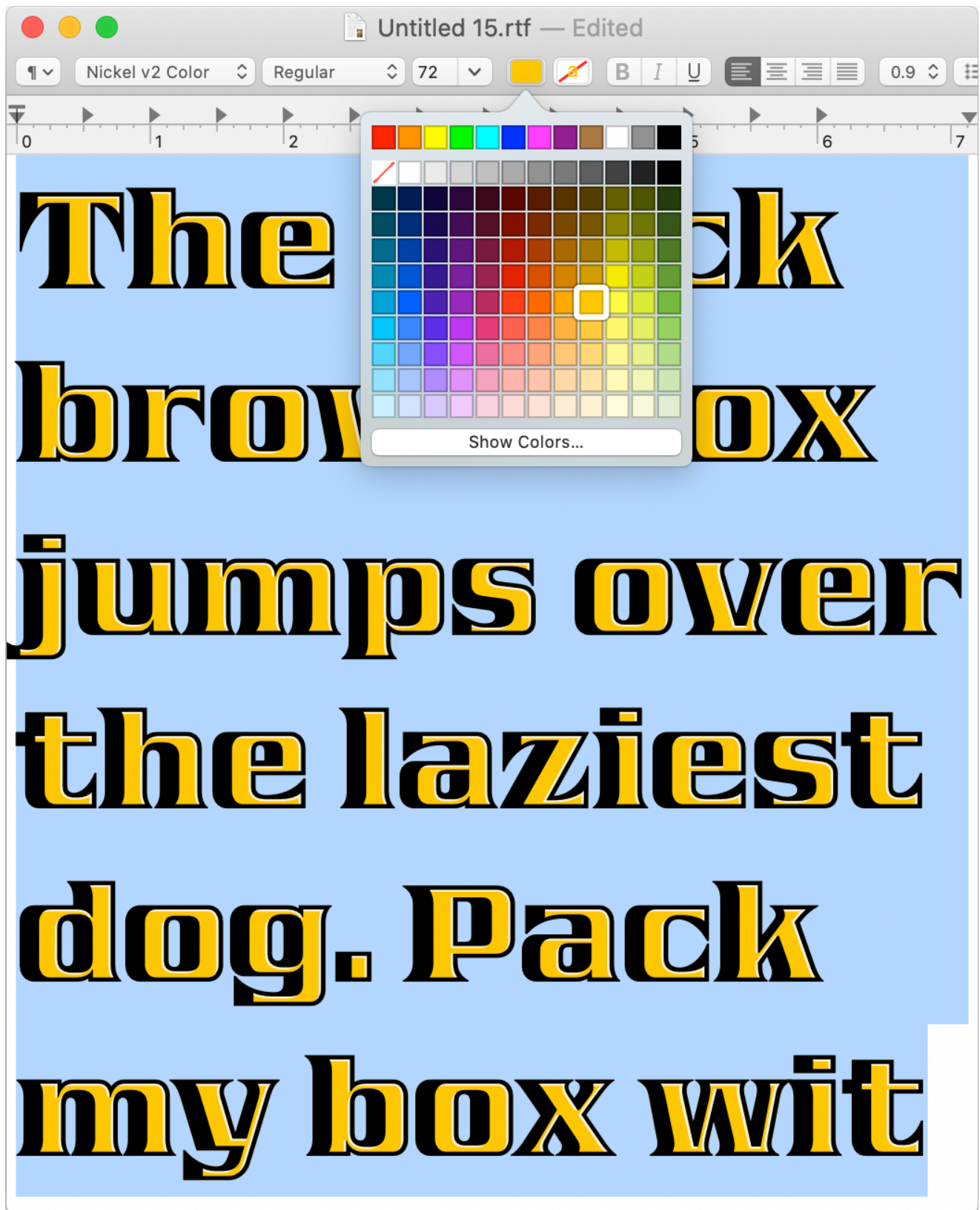

In addition to setting predefined color palettes, I made a Nickel color font whose open forms respond to the current fill color of your document. And it even responds to dark mode!









**Nickel** is a stocky engraver's alphabet based on the inscription of a 1918 Chinese banknote. In this face, the traditionally round letters (like **O** and **S**) are straight-sided, as if chiseled from a block. Meanwhile, the traditionally straight letters (like **H** and **N**) are dominated by the sweeping curves of large, bracketed serifs. Nickel shares the monumentality of the lettering on today's American currency, but its squarish forms add a peculiar strength and energy with overtones of the 1970s classic typeface, *Serpentine*.
