

Housing Discrimination

Don't Ignore It, Report it!

It is illegal to discriminate in housing based on these protected classes:

- Race
- Ancestry
- Religion
- Age (over 40)
- Sexual Orientation
- Marital Status
- Military Status
- National Origin
- Disability
- Sex
- Gender Identity
- Parental Status
- Source of Income
- Color

Prohibited acts include:

- Refusal to rent to or sell
- Requiring different terms or conditions in renting such as higher security deposits, cosigners, or higher income requirements
- Refusing to make repairs to a rental unit
- Evicting a tenant for discriminatory reasons
- Sexual harassment of a tenant by the property owner or their agents






If you believe you have been a victim of housing discrimination, don't ignore it, report it to the CCHR.
