Help build computer science programs in high schools

The Microsoft Philanthropies Technology Education and Learning Support (TEALS) Program helps high schools build equitable, inclusive computer science (CS) programs, with a focus on serving students historically excluded from learning technical skills because of race, gender, or geography. TEALS helps classroom teachers build CS skills by pairing them with volunteers from the tech industry and proven curricula.

You can help close the CS education gap

- **43%** of high school in the US do not offer a foundational CS courses. Among those with access, disparities persist. Nationally only **31%** of students enrolled in CS are young women.
- **67%** of all new jobs in STEM are in computing.
- **17%** of students who learn CS are more likely to attend college and excel at problem-solving.
